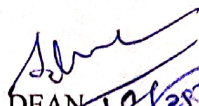
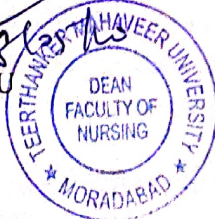

REVIEW OF ACTION TAKEN

B1. To implement the revised Examination Regulation in the B.Sc. Nursing syllabus as per INC amendment, Notification No. F. No. 1-6/B.Sc.(N)/2025–INC dated 13/08/2025.

- Prof. Dr. S.P. Subashini informed the members that the amended Examination Regulations as per INC Notification had been implemented in the B.Sc. Nursing curriculum from the Academic Session 2025–26.
- Prof. Sunita Ahlawat and Prof. Reddeppa Sreeraja Kumar appreciated the timely implementation of the revised examination regulations and observed that the amendment would provide greater academic flexibility to students while maintaining academic standards.
- The BoS members reviewed the implementation status and unanimously ratified the action taken.

B2. To ratify and implement the M.Sc. Nursing course electives as per INC Notification F.No. 1-5/2021–INC dated 4th October 2021.

- Prof. Jitendra Singh informed the members that the prescribed electives in the M.Sc. Nursing programme had been incorporated into the curriculum framework and communicated to all concerned departments.
- Prof. Dr. Jasline M and Prof. Shivani Kaul appreciated the inclusion of electives, stating that the initiative would strengthen advanced nursing competencies, promote academic flexibility, and support specialization among postgraduate nursing students.
- All members reviewed the implementation process and unanimously ratified the action taken.

B3. Discussion regarding the feedback of the stakeholders.

- The committee was informed that stakeholder feedback from students, faculty members, alumni, and subject experts had been reviewed and corresponding action had been initiated.
- Prof. Ram Niwas and Prof. Sunita Ahlawat appreciated the efforts taken to incorporate career guidance and motivational sessions into the academic framework.
- Prof. Dr. Sheuli Sen emphasized that continuous stakeholder feedback and Action Taken Reports (ATR) play an important role in improving academic quality, student satisfaction, and institutional development.
- The BoS members unanimously appreciated the action taken and recommended continuation of the stakeholder feedback mechanism as a regular quality improvement initiative.

To approve the inclusion of a MOOC course in the Even Semester. • Prof. Jitendra Singh informed the members that the proposal for inclusion of MOOC courses had been initiated and discussions regarding suitable platforms and implementation strategies were underway. • Prof. Shivani Kaul and Prof. Dr. Sunil Kumar Dular appreciated the initiative and highlighted that MOOC integration would provide students with exposure to flexible, globally recognized, and self-paced learning opportunities. • The Board members reviewed the progress and unanimously ratified the action taken.

(Annexure-1) • Prof. Jitendra Singh presented the revised panel of External Practical Examiners for M.Sc. Nursing, B.Sc. Nursing, and P.B.B.Sc. Nursing programmes before the Board members for review and approval. • Prof. Priyanka A. Masih & Mrs. Shivani Kaul emphasized the importance of maintaining a well-qualified and updated panel of external examiners with adequate teaching and clinical expertise. • Prof. Dr. Jasline M, Prof. Vijimol G and Prof. Ram Niwas suggested that the examiner list should continue to maintain separate categorization for Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes to ensure academic and practical evaluation standards. • The BoS members reviewed the revised examiner list and unanimously recommended approval and implementation for the Academic Session 2026–27.

D2. Review and Implementation of Value-Added Courses for the Academic Year 2026–27 for P.B.B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing Programs, including introduction of two new VAC courses:

i. The Art of Being Happy

ii. Digital Anger and Trolling Psychology: Understanding, Prevention and Positive Online Behavior (Annexure-2)

- Prof. Jitendra Singh apprised the members regarding the continuation and review of existing Value-Added Courses (VACs) for P.B.B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing programmes for the Academic Session 2026–27.
- The newly proposed VAC courses “The Art of Being Happy” and “Digital Anger and Trolling Psychology: Understanding, Prevention and Positive Online Behavior” were introduced before the Board for discussion and approval.
- Prof. Priyanka A. Masih, Dr. Subashini S P and Prof. Mr. Basavaraj Mudhol appreciated the inclusion of these contemporary and student-centered courses, emphasizing that they would support emotional well-being, positive mental health, responsible digital behavior, and professional conduct among nursing students.
- Prof. Jasline M, Mrs. Shivani Kaul and Dr. Ram Kumar Garg highlighted that the proposed courses are highly relevant in the present academic and social environment and would contribute towards holistic personality development and psychosocial competence among learners.
- The Board of Studies members unanimously recommended continuation of the existing VACs and approved the introduction of the two new VAC courses for implementation from the Academic Session 2026–27.

D3. Review and Approval for introduction of Short-Term Course titled “Fundamentals of Clinical Research and Role of AI in Clinical Practice.” (Annexure-3)

- Prof. Jitendra Singh presented the proposal for introduction of a Short-Term Course titled “Fundamentals of Clinical Research and Role of AI in Clinical Practice” with the objective of enhancing students’ understanding of clinical research methodology, evidence-based practice, and emerging applications of Artificial Intelligence in healthcare
- Prof. Priyanka A. Masih appreciated the proposal and emphasized that research competency and AI literacy are becoming essential components in modern nursing and healthcare education.
- Prof. Ram Niwas and Dr Jasline M observed that the proposed course would strengthen students’ analytical skills, research aptitude, ethical understanding, and awareness regarding technology-enabled healthcare practices.

- Prof. Dr. Sheuli Sen further suggested that practical demonstrations, case discussions, and exposure to AI-assisted healthcare applications may be incorporated within the course structure.

- The Board of Studies members unanimously approved the introduction of the Short-Term Course titled “Fundamentals of Clinical Research and Role of AI in Clinical Practice” for implementation from the Academic Session 2026–27.

D4. Review and Integration of MOOC Courses.

- Prof. Jitendra Singh presented the proposal regarding systematic integration of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) into the curriculum for both odd and even semesters across academic programmes.

- The members were informed that the integration of MOOC courses aims to enhance learning opportunities by providing access to flexible, self-paced, interdisciplinary, and globally recognized educational resources.

- Prof. Priyanka A. Masih appreciated the proposal and emphasized that MOOCs can significantly contribute towards skill enhancement, self-directed learning, digital competency, and exposure to emerging healthcare concepts.

- Prof. (Dr.) S. P. Subashini and Prof. (Dr.) Varun Toshniwal emphasized that the integration of MOOCs should be implemented in a structured manner with proper monitoring and academic alignment.

- The Board of Studies members unanimously recommended the structured integration of MOOC courses in both odd and even semesters, subject to approval by the competent academic authority and implementation guidelines of the University.

D5. Any other matter with the permission of the Chair:

Implementation of Revised INC Examination Regulation (Notification – 2 of 2026) (Annexure-4)

- After obtaining permission from the Chair, Prof. Jitendra Singh apprised the members regarding the latest amendment issued by the Indian Nursing Council vide Notification No. F. No. 1-6/B.Sc.(N)/2026–INC dated 09 January 2026 concerning the revision of examination regulations in the B.Sc. Nursing programme.

The Board discussed the key amendments, including:

The amended Para 16 will read as under:

The candidate shall appear for exams in each semester:

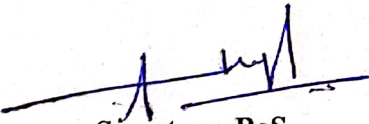
- The candidate shall cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for the **final semester examination (8th semester)**
- The maximum period to complete the course/program successfully should not exceed 8 years.

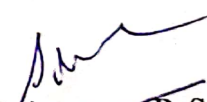
The amendment is effective for the candidates appearing for 5th & subsequent semesters of BSc(N) w.e.f. the year 2025. This amendment is applicable for the all students awaiting to complete 5th & subsequent semester, irrespective of the admission year.

Further clarification:

-The students should have cleared all the previous examinations up to seventh semester before appearing for 8th semester examination. If the internal assessment and attendance requirements are completed in the previous examinations but failed in one or more subject / course, they may be permitted to appear for the final 8th semester exam from home, not having to stay in the hostel; however, may attend classes or clinicals if desired by the students.

- Prof. Priyanka A. Masih and Prof. (Dr.) S. P. Subashini informed that the INC has already circulated the amended notification; therefore, it is recommended to implement the same. The members discussed the matter in detail and unanimously agreed with the recommendation.
