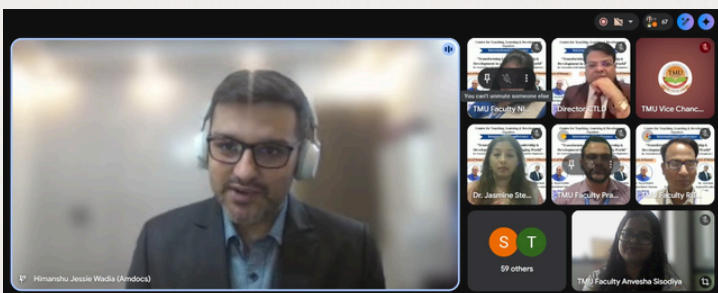
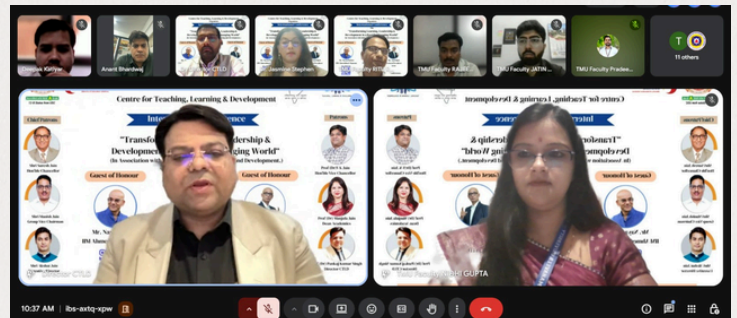

✳ **Write to Reveal: Unlocking Minds Through Graphoanalysis and Graphotherapy**

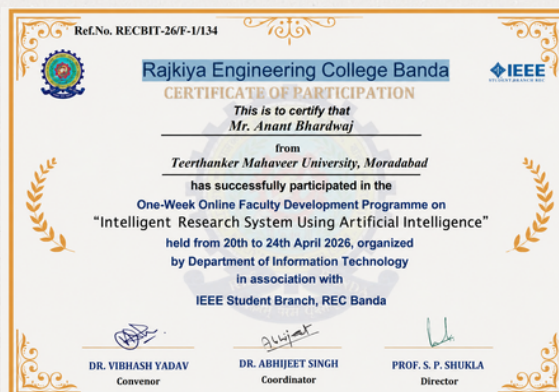
