Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at Moradabad on... 20/02/2025

BETWEEN

Teerthanker Mahaveer University (TMU), Moradabad is State Private University established by Act No. 30 of 2008 of the Government of Uttar Pradesh and has been duly approved by University Grants Commission under Section 2 of UGC Act, 1956, situated at Delhi Road, NH-9 Moradabad-244001(U.P) (hereinafter referred as **TMU**) which term or expression, unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its successor(s) assignee(s) through its duly authorized representative, **Dean – Academics, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad(U.P).**

The University is accredited with NAAC A Grade and has to its credit ICAR accreditation, NBA (Computer Science & Engineering) and 12B status from UGC. The multi- disciplinary University offers career- oriented programmes at all levels i.e. Diploma, UG, PG and Doctoral degrees across diverse streams namely, Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, Nursing, Paramedical Sciences, Physiotherapy, Physical Education, Management, Engineering, Law, Fine Arts, Jain Studies, and Agriculture to meet rising aspirations of the youth and are approved by the concerned regulatory and statutory bodies.

Sprawling across a vast campus of 140 acres, the University is envisioned to be internationally recognized as a premier institution of excellence, providing quality education, research, and consultancy services to the global society.

Teerthanker Mahaveer University, having its campus at Moradabad hereinafter referred to as ‘**TMU**’ (Which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the **First Part**

AND

Revival Child Rehab and development Centre, Moradabad having its registered office at H. No. 5/1 Sector 7B, Buddhi Vihar, Phase 2, Moradabad - 244001 (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns) of the **Second Part**

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WHEREAS:

1. TMU is a University approved by UGC.
2. Revival Child Rehab Centre is engaged in the field of healthcare that provides physiotherapeutic, occupational therapeutic treatments to be pediatric patients.
3. TMU is willing to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Revival Child Rehab Centre for the skills enhancement training program.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERE TO AS UNDER:

1. Objective:




The objective of this MOU is to enable students of TMU to learn pediatric patient handling that would enhance their employability.

2. Period of MOU:

This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of Two year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the 2 years duration period.

3. Roles & Responsibilities of TMU:

- a. TMU shall be responsible to nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the engagement. The person so appointed would act as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the proposed initiative.
- b. TMU shall share in their letterhead the details of the students who will attend the aforesaid training program with Revival Child Rehab Centre like name, email ID, contact details, qualification (along with the year of completion/pursuing) and other documents as per Revival Child Rehab Centre requirements.
- c. It would be the responsibility of TMU to ensure that proper publicity of the Program is made through TMU website.
- d. To encourage the students to register for the Program by informing them about the benefits of the program.



- e. **TMU** to refrain conducting any of their training or call with the students when students are posted in Revival Child Rehab Centre.
- f. It would be their responsibility to ensure that all their students adhere to training/posting schedule.
- g. To provide all the support services and facilities to **Revival Child Rehab Centre** during the conduct of the said Training Program.
- h. To coordinate with Revival Child Rehab Centre and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by Revival Child Rehab Centre, as per schedule communicated by Revival Child Rehab Centre.
- i. To provide the placement, if possible, to the students who have undergone the aforesaid training Revival Child Rehab Centre.

4. Roles & Responsibilities of Revival Child Rehab Centre:

- a. Revival Child Rehab Centre shall be responsible to provide access to employability enhancement related activities by providing clinical evaluative skills.
- b. Revival Child Rehab Centre will provide patient handling skills to the students.
- c. Revival Child Rehab Centre will facilitate placement of students with their client/patients and may also recruit for their own requirements.

5. Other Terms & Conditions:

Following are the other terms and conditions of MOU:

- a. The students enrolled should complete the training as scheduled.
- b. Program Coordinator to be appointed by TMU
- c. TPO's active support and participation is required for smooth & efficient conduct of the program.
- d. TMU shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of Revival Child Rehab Centre / in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from Revival Child Rehab Centre.

6. Commercials:

This skills enhancement **training program** is free of cost. Revival Child Rehab Centre shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or TMU for conducting the aforesaid training program.

7. Limitations and Warranties:

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavor to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

8. Termination:




- a. Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms or non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- b. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavor that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

9. Entirety & Amendment:

This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU. Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

10. Intellectual Proprietary Rights:

All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.





11. Confidential Information:


- a. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is inconsequential or obvious.
- b. Already in its possession other than as a result of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than as a result of a breach of this clause.
- c. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party so as to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.
- d. TMU agrees not to deal directly or enter into any agreement with any clients of Revival Child Rehab Centre and should not share any information with them related to the training during the term of the agreement and also after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

12. Force Majeure:

- j. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- k. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.







13. Non-Solicitation:

TMU agrees that during the term of this Agreement and for a period of two (2) years after the termination or expiry thereof, it shall not, directly or indirectly, employ, contract, solicit, hire or otherwise utilize the services of an existing employee of Revival Child Rehab Centre.

14. Jurisdiction and Arbitration:

- a. In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Moradabad alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh.
- b. Any dispute arising out of, in relation to or in respect to this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MOU. In case a settlement is not arrived at within fifteen (15) days of reference, the dispute/s shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The place of arbitration shall be Moradabad, India.

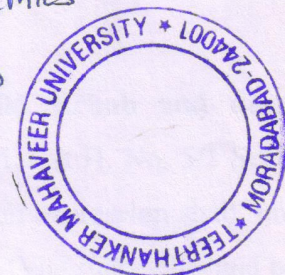
