This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) sets for the terms and understanding between Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad (Partner 1) and **The Indian Pharmacy Graduates' Association (IPGA)** (Partner 2) for continuing professional development programs for pharmacy faculty and students.

**I. Background:**

**Partner 1:**

Teerthanker Mahaveer University (TMU), Moradabad (U.P.), is a State Private University established under Act No. 30 of 2008 of the Government of Uttar Pradesh and is duly recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956. The University is situated at Delhi Road, NH-9, Moradabad-244001 (U.P.) (hereinafter referred to as "TMU"), which term or expression, unless repugnant to the context

thereof, shall mean and include its successors and assigns acting through its duly authorized representative, Dean–Academics, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad (U.P.).

TMU is a NAAC ‘A’ Grade accredited, multidisciplinary University, having also received ICAR accreditation, NBA accreditation (Computer Science & Engineering), and 12(B) status from UGC. The University offers career-oriented programmes at the Diploma, Undergraduate, Postgraduate, and Doctoral levels across a wide range of disciplines including Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, Nursing, Paramedical Sciences, Physiotherapy, Physical Education, Management, Engineering, Law, Fine Arts, Jain Studies, and Agriculture, all approved by the concerned regulatory and statutory bodies.

Sprawling over a 140-acre campus, TMU is envisioned to be internationally recognized as a premier institution of excellence, committed to providing quality education, research, and consultancy services to society at large.

Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy (TMCOP), established in 2008, is a constituent college of Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad (U.P.). The pharmacy programmes offered by the College are approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

#### **Partner 2:**

The Indian Pharmacy Graduates’ Association (IPGA) is a national professional organization established in 1973 with the objective of promoting the professional growth, recognition, and welfare of pharmacy graduates in India. Registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, IPGA represents the interests of pharmacy graduates working across academia, industry, regulatory bodies, hospitals, and community pharmacy settings.

The IPGA is an active constituent member of the India Pharmaceutical Congress Association (IPCA), the apex body of pharmacy professionals in India. Through this affiliation, IPGA contributes to national- level discussions and policy deliberations related to pharmaceutical education, professional practice, and healthcare delivery. The association aims to strengthen the role of pharmacy graduates in the healthcare system and enhance their professional status both nationally and globally. IPGA is affiliated with the India Pharmaceutical Congress Association (IPCA), a federal body comprising five major pharmaceutical associations: IPGA, the Indian Pharmaceutical Association (IPA), the Indian Hospital Pharmacists Association (IHPA), the Association of Pharmaceutical Teachers of India (APTI), and the All-India Drugs Control Officers Confederation (AIDCOC). The association’s core mission is to enhance the professional status of pharmacy graduates and secure their rightful place in the pharmaceutical

and allied industries. With 17 state branches and 11 local chapter, IPGA has a strong presence across India. It also actively promotes engagement through its IPGA Student Forum and IPGA Women's Forum, both of which are organized at the central and state levels to support the professional growth of students and women in pharmacy.


With a wide network of state and local branches across the country and a strong membership base, IPGA plays a vital role in continuing professional development. It regularly organizes national and state conferences, seminars, workshops, and continuing education programs, providing platforms for knowledge exchange and skill enhancement. These activities help members stay updated with recent advances in pharmaceutical sciences, regulatory affairs, clinical pharmacy, and industrial practices, IPGA disseminates professional information and updates through its newsletter, "IPGA Today," which highlights scientific developments, association activities, and member achievements.

The IPGA Students Forum (SF) was founded in 2017 in Delhi, India. To date, there are four Students Forums constituted in different states. The aims and objectives of the SF are to not only disseminate information about activities among the student fraternity in all pharmacy colleges of the states but also to highlight common issues faced by the student community in front of the association for their speedy resolution.

## II. Purpose:

This MOU will conduct Pharmacy workshops, special short-term professional development programs, personality development programs, and other cooperative efforts set-forth between **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy (Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad)** and IPGA Uttar Pradesh State Branch from time to time. Also, the IPGA shall provide career guidance to pharmacy students through its IPGA Student Forum (IPGA-SF) by conducting workshops, research- project- based webinars (e.g., "EREVNA" and "Project D.O.P.A.M.I.N.E."), conferences and awareness programmes. Not less than 2 joint activities & training programs, 1 workshop, 1 conference and 1 job fair shall be conducted within the duration of one year. This MoU will also act as a source of observation and motivation for the all-round development of students in particular and institute in general.

### **III. Roles & Responsibilities:**

#### **1. Roles & Responsibilities of Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad.**

The Principal of Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy will be the In-charge of the **IPGA Moradabad** component of this collaborative venture. The Principal will nominate a single point of contact to communicate with his/her counterpart at the IPGA Uttar Pradesh State Branch end.

#### **2. Major Roles of Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Moradabad**

- i. Give inputs for delivering various programs suitable to the objective of the collaboration.
- ii. Ensure adequate publicity of the programs conducted and enrol interested students to participate in the programs.
- iii. Maintain records of the conducted programs (programme details, attendance sheets, contact details of the students, photographs, feedback forms, etc.) and share with IPGA.
- iv. Motivate students and faculty members to take membership of IPGA and become part of SF of IPGA.
- v. Nominate a sufficient number of under- and post-graduate students as volunteers to support IPGA's inter & intra-college activities that strengthen the SF of IPGA.
- vi. Provide articles, news or any other information on a regular basis to be published in the official publication of IPGA.
- vii. Conduct any other activity to be mutually beneficial to both institutions.


#### **3. Roles & Responsibilities of IPGA-Uttar Pradesh State Branch:**

The President of IPGA will be the In-charge of the IPGA component of this collaborative effort. The President will nominate a single point of contact to coordinate all activities with his/her counterpart.

#### **4. Major Roles of IPGA- Uttar Pradesh State Branch:**

- i. Provide career guidance to pharmacy students through webinars, workshops, conferences, and training.
- ii. Provide assistance in conducting Job Fairs at the Institute premises.
- iii. Provide personality development programs for the benefit of students.
- iv. Impart professional training through deputation of faculty/resource persons.
- v. Impart training of laboratory instruments to update knowledge of faculty and students.

- vi. Regular circulation of pharmacy magazines, namely, IPGA Today to all the trained participants for constant knowledge upgradation.


**5. Roles & Responsibilities in common:**

- i. Identifying training needs of students.
- ii. Designing and development of modules of training programs.
- iii. Designing feedback forms and participation certificates.
- iv. Designing brochures of activities / events to be organized / conducted.

**IV. General Terms & Conditions:**

1. **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy (Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad)** can charge nominal participation fees (pre-decided in consultation with IPGA- Uttar Pradesh State Branch) from the attendees which shall be used as fund raising component for conducting programs.
2. Certificates (jointly carrying IPGA and **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, (Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad names & logos)** shall be printed by **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** for events organized in collaboration.
3. **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** shall promote and encourage IPGA membership among the participants during the programs.
4. **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** shall promote and nurture student volunteers for the programs.
5. **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** shall keep IPGA informed about the schedule of the training programs in advance.
6. **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** shall display banners regarding IPGA and **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy (Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad)** collaboration at its Institute and on its website.
7. IPGA also shall display banners regarding IPGA and **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, (Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad)** collaboration on its website as well as its publications as mentioned above from time to time.
8. No financial liabilities are expected other than, that **Teerthanker Mahaveer College of Pharmacy, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad** shall be expected to




