

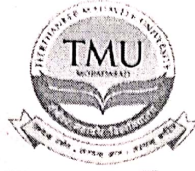

1. Brief overview:


Sasakawa India Leprosy Foundation (S-ILF), having its office on the 2nd Floor, IETE Building, 2 Institutional Area, Lodhi Road, New Delhi 110 003, is a Registered Indian Charitable Trust. Established with the vision of Mr Yohei Sasakawa, WHO Goodwill Ambassador for Leprosy Elimination and the recipient of the Gandhi Peace Prize, the organisation works for the cause of Leprosy and the persons affected by Leprosy and their families, living in various Leprosy colonies in India.

I. Purpose

The Parties recognise the benefits to be derived from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further promotion and understanding of Leprosy, and its causes, demystifying stigma and discrimination associated with the disease. (hereafter, collectively referred to as the "Field").

The purpose of this MOU is to define the areas for support and partnerships in which the Parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between Sasakawa-India Leprosy Foundation, New Delhi and Teerthanker Mahaveer University

College of Paramedical Sciences, Moradabad, UP in the Field intending to benefit from each other's initiatives and work and to support awareness, sensitisation and advocacy initiatives in the field of Leprosy.

The MOU involves collaboration between two parties for raising awareness in the field of Leprosy in terms of sensitisation and advocacy efforts which is binding on parties. Both Parties shall seek to promote:

1. Both Parties value each other's interest in exploring the possibility of collaborating regarding awareness generation on Leprosy.
2. Collaboration in Teaching/ Training, Consultancy Activities, and partners in spreading awareness, sensitisation, and any other area of mutual interest to both Parties.
3. Exchange of Academic, Research and IEC Material while adhering to prevailing copyright laws.
4. Inviting S-ILF for any academic opportunity like paper presentation etc
5. Joint organisation of events like Youth Festivals, conferences, workshops, trainings, etc.



II. Scope

This MOU sets forth the intentions of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction and does not create any legally binding commitments. If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each Party's contributions, deliverables, and budgets.

III. Objectives

1. Raising Awareness: TMU and S-ILF will jointly celebrate important days like Anti-Leprosy Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Health Day, etc., to raise awareness about leprosy.
2. Sensitisation Workshops: With the help of S-ILF, TMU will organise sensitisation workshops on leprosy for its students.
3. Awareness Drives: TMU will assist S-ILF in organising awareness drives on its campus through awareness walks, oath-taking, and placing banners/standees/selfie points in public spaces for specific periods.
4. Health Camps: With the help of its paramedic department, TMU will organise health camps in nearby leprosy colonies.

5. Branding: TMU will allow the use of its logo and name as a partner in leprosy awareness initiatives with prior approval.
6. Event Organisation: TMU will assist S-ILF in organising events like Youth Festivals and ensure good participation from its students.
7. Mentorship: TMU will provide mentorship to students from a leprosy background, supported by S-ILF.

IV. Finance

Neither institution shall incur any financial obligations under this agreement. Applications for financial support towards the co-operation and individual activities planned under this agreement will be transparent and undertaken with mutual consent. Other sources of finances raised to support these joint projects can be pursued with the knowledge of the other through intimation in writing.

V. Responsibility for implementation

Activities to be organised under this agreement will be the responsibility of the Heads of both institutions or of persons designated by them. National regulations and customs shall be mutually respected.

VI. Duration and Alteration of the Agreement

The MOU will come into effect on the date of signature by both parties and shall continue for two years. On completion of two years, the MOU may be renewed for such periods and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the parties to this MOU.


VII Termination

This Memorandum may be terminated by either party with two months' notice and/or may be terminated by either party, after the completion of any specific activity/activities in the process with mutual consent.

VIII. Confidentiality

The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MOU. If either party wishes to disclose information, it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Parties will enter into a written non-disclosure agreement.

IX. No Partnership, Association, Trust, or Joint Venture

Nothing under this MOU shall be deemed to neither constitute or create an association, trust, partnership, or Joint Venture between the parties nor constitute any party the agent of any other party for any purpose.



X. Matters not provided in

If any doubt arises as to the interpretation of the provisions of this MOU or as to matters not provided therein, parties to this MOU shall consult with each other for each instance and resolve such doubts in good faith.

XI. Jurisdiction

All disputes are to be settled within the jurisdiction of Delhi courts.
