Agenda 1: Offer of Open Optional Courses-

After discussion & deliberations in the meeting two following open optional courses (open electives) were finalized to be offered to other colleges / departments of the university from College of Agriculture Sciences w.e.f. academic session 2019-20 -

- i. Agriculture Heritage (L-3, T-0, P-0, C-3)
- ii. Food Safety & Standards (L-2, T-0, P-1, C-3)

Note - Students of B. Sc. Agriculture Sciences can opt two open optional courses (open electives) offered by university in 2nd or 3rd year of programme. However, out of the two courses offered by university, a student can opt one course in ODD semester & the other in EVEN semester of the same programme year as preferred by student.

Agenda 2: Approval of Course Outcomes (COs) & Programme Outcomes (POs)

In the curriculum of B. Sc. Agriculture, Course Outcomes (COs) & Programme Outcomes (POs) were discussed and finalized in the present syllabus w.e.f. academic session 2019-20. Valuable comments by the experts, chairperson and members of the board were incorporated in the list.

Agenda 3: Introduction of new syllabus of English course.

a. Hon'ble Chairperson of the board brought into the notice of experts and the members the modifications in English course of undergraduate programmes at university. b. A discussion was made in the meeting regarding Value Added Courses on 'Soft Skills for Professionals' to be introduced in IIIrd and Vth year of B.Sc.(Hons.) Agriculture programme from the academic session 2019-20. Out of the two value added courses, one course will be offered in Vth semester (IIIrd year) and the other in VIIIth semester (IVth year) of the programme. The value added courses shall be carried out by the Centre For Teaching, Learning and Development (CTLD) of University. The courses will remain qualifying in nature. It is compulsory for students to score 45% marks to qualify the course.

After a through discussion with the experts, the board bestowed its consent for the courses.

Agenda 4: Changes in the maximum & minimum credits.

A discussion was made with the experts regarding changes in maximum & minimum credits since the total credits of programme got modified due to credit change in English communication syllabus & introduction of open optional courses (open electives) w.e.f. academic session 2019-20. Credits were finally approved by the experts and board members.
