So, it can be kept if anyone of the semester with the maximum 20 hours</li> <li>-Prof. Ram Kumar said given number of hours INC syllabus 800 hours in each semester so it is difficult to implement practically and also point out that again it will be disparity in marks cards of students with other Universities and it can be separate grade certificate.</li> </ul> <p><b>D2.2</b> Whether to continue implementing open elective subjects (multidisciplinary) in III, IV year in existing TMU Syllabus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Mrs. Deepa Chug and Prof. Ram Kumar have recommended to replace existing TMU open elective courses (Eg.
