- In Course: Information and Communication Technology of all Programs add topic "E-Learning and Online Classes "in Unit-III and Topic "E-Libraries" shift to unit-V from unit-III.
- In Course: Critical Understanding of ICI" Course Code BED 452 of Program B.Ed. add following topics "Creation & Operation of E-mail account and management of Google Drive"; "Use of Audio-Visual Aids Like: Computer, Projector, Android Mobile in education"; "Conduct & Operate at least five Online Learning Classes through Different Application"; "Creation and Operation of You-tube Account for demonstrate five audio/video lectures related to their Pedagogy subject.
- in H.F.L.Ed. Program one course; Understanding Discipline and Subjects Course Code BELED 401 was added in the Fourth Semester
- A discussion was made with the experts regarding changes inminimum credits since the total credits of programs got modified due to credit change in English communication syllabus and other courses w.e.f. academic session2019-20.
- Credits were finally approved by the experts and boardmembers. Minimum credit required for B.A./B.Sc. degree is 141, B.A.- B.Ed. / B.Sc.-B.Ed. Integrated degree is 213, B.Ed. degree is 90 and B.El.Ed. degree is 193.
