### **20.4 Reporting of Accreditation of B.Tech (CSE) programme by NBA**

The members were apprised about the accreditation of B.Tech (CSE) programme by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) for the period of three years w.e.f from the academic session 2022-23 to 2024-25. Prof S.H. Ansari congratulated the team and suggested that the other departments of the University should also take initiatives for accreditation of the programmes being offered by them, esp. other engineering programmes, management and pharmacy programmes. The Vice Chancellor briefed that the efforts are being taken to make preparations for the accreditation of the MBA and B.Pharm programmes through international accrediting agencies as these programmes cannot be accredited by NBA, being non-AICTE approved programmes.

1. For undergraduate programmes where English is being taught through 4 courses, English will now be taught through 2 courses, namely **English Communication 1** and **English Communication 2**, the syllabi of which is attached herewith (Annexure-01).
2. For undergraduate programmes where English is being taught through 2 courses, the number of courses will remain the same. However, the syllabus will be replaced by the syllabi for **English Communication 1** and **English Communication 2** (Annexure-01).
3. For undergraduate programmes where English is being taught through 1 course, the number of courses will remain the same. However, the content has been revised to avoid redundancy and English will be taught through a course named as **English Communication**, the syllabi for which is at Annexure-02.
4. Topics of Soft Skills, i.e., Building Self Confidence, Etiquettes & manners and Job Oriented Skills (Cover letter, resume, CV, Interview, Group Discussion, Corporate and Professional Ethics etc) have been removed (as highlighted in the attached syllabus) as they are already being covered by the courses offered by CTLD.
5. Certain topics spread out across courses, i.e. Error Correction, Sentence structure and formation related topics, Vocabulary related topics, Basics of Communication, Presentations, etc, have been merged.
6. Value based text reading would now be a part of Reading and Understanding.
7. New topics, i.e. Everyday Expressions, Commonly used verbs, Articles, Note taking and Note making, Solving Parajumbles, Technical jargons, Public Speaking, Picture Perception and Role plays, have been included.
8. The L-T-P-C scheme will be 1-0-2-2.
