Subject: Change in Evaluation Scheme of Aptitude courses from Session 2022-23

Need of Change: Till July 2022, the status of CTLD courses was Value Added Courses (VAC). However, during NAAC preparation, it was brought to the notice of university authorities that these courses being skills enhancement courses cannot be kept as value add and needs to be kept as skills enhancement courses (SEC). Therefore, for programmes commenced from session 2022-23, these courses are converted to SEC category with one credit each.

For programmes older than session 2022-23, soft skills courses were in category of practical and Aptitude courses were in theory category. However, since Aptitude courses are also skills enhancement courses, hence need to be kept in practical category. Recently, during discussion with colleges coordinators it came out that practical courses cannot be evaluated through theory process as in practical category there is no

provision of CTs and end semester examination tabs on ERP.

In view of above, following evaluation has been made from the academic session 2022-23 for Aptitude course:

a) For Odd sem (2022-23)

CT-1, CT-2 are already conducted and marks are available with trainers. Hence, it is recommended that CT-3 and external examination be conducted as per old procedure for which CoE will give separate dates.

- Marks of best 2 CTs (weightage of 15 marks each), attendance in class (10 marks) and an assignment (10 marks) would be considered.
- Each CT would be of 30 marks (30 Questions, 1 mark each, 1 hour duration).

• Faculty will calculate the marks of best 2 CTs **manually** and upload it on ERP under practical internal marks tagged as **Assignment 1 and Assignment 2** (weightage of 15 marks each) and one assignment as **Assignment 3** (10 marks).
